## TAC TANKERS 2010 Reunion Albuquerque, NM May 19-22

Our reunion site this year is the Hotel Albuquerque located in Historic Old Town. The address is 800 Rio Grande Blvd., NW, Albuquerque NM 87104. There are 188 guest rooms, 20 suites with all the amenities, plus 2 lounges, 2 restaurants, and complimentary parking. Also available is a pool and Chapel which may be used for our Memorial Service.

Our Hospitality Room will be the Club Level Lounge and the Banquet will be in the Franciscan Ball Room on Saturday evening. The rate will be \$109 per night with the same rate 3 days before and after according to availability. ### Tour Descriptions

#### **Wednesday-Tour 1 St. Clair Bistro & Winery Dinner** (3hours) \$ 23pp.

At 6:30 we will stroll one block from the hotel for our first activity of the reunion. There is a choice of 4 dinners. OPTIONAL-a Wine Tasting (5:30-6:30), get six 1-oz glasses for \$6.00. That's on your own.

#### **Thursday -Tour 2 Guided Walking Tour of Historic Old Town.** (75 min) \$5pp

Certified history guides dispel rumors and myths about "Duke City" on a tour through the streets and alleys of one of the oldest towns in North America. Tour 9am-10:15 followed by time to sight see, shop and lunch on your own. Lists of restaurants and shops will be in Registration packets.

#### **Tour 3 OPTION#1-City Tour and Sandia Tram Flight** (3 1/2 hrs) \$25pp

City Tour down Central Ave. (Old Rt. 66) and on to the top of Sandia Peak (10,378 ft) on the world's longest jig back Tram. The 2.7 mi. trip take 15min. each way. Observe 11,000 sq. miles of 360 degree panoramic view. Refreshments at top or bottom of tram. **Read cautions on Pg. 1 of Newsletter!** The bus will then take you to the Sandia Casino & Resort for dinner on your own (4 locations)

#### **Tour 4 OPTION #2-International Balloon Museum** (1 1/2 hrs) \$15pp

At 3:30 depart for the museum. Each October over 850 hot air balloons participate in the International Balloon fiesta, a spectacular event of sights, sounds, colors and piloting skills. The museum is on the grounds of the fiesta. The bus will then take you to the Sandia Casino & Resort for dinner with the Tram group and transport everyone back to the hotel by 8pm.

#### **Friday- Tour 5 Santa Fe Tour** (7 hours) \$60 pp.

The bus departs hotel at 8:30 with a stop in Madrid (old mining town) on the Turquoise Trail to Santa Fe, with a city tour. Time for lunch and exploring on your own. Return to hotel by 3:30.
